BUILDING A BVMI FOR A BETTER TOMORROW



Maria lives in Garfield with her 12-year-old son and has been receiving primary and gynecological care at BVMI for over 10 years. Originally from Poland, she has been living in the United States for 20 years. Although she has a chemistry degree from her home country. she has been cleaning houses since she came here because it allowed her the flexibility to care for her son.

Maria learned about BVMI while cleaning the home of a long-time BVMI donor. And, as "small world" stories go, she also knew BVMI founder Dr. Sam Cassell and his wife Carol, having helped the Cassells serve Passover dinner to their quests for several years.

When Maria found out that BVMI is opening a clinic in Garfield about a three-minute walk from her home - she was delighted, noting that going there will be

easier for her, saving time and travel costs.

She is also happy to learn that Garfield Unity Pantry - a choice food pantry – is at the same location, administered by the Community Food Bank of NJ. She currently picks up food from an Englewood food pantry, which is more than 10 miles and nearly a half hour away.

BVMI strengthens our patients' lives in other ways. For example, BVMI's Case Manager, Rosa, suggested that Maria find an international credential evaluator to help translate her Polish chemistry degree to use in the United States. Rosa is connecting her to employment services to put that degree to use and find a job working in a lab.

The excitement is growing as we look forward to opening BVMI@ UnityHealth, our second clinic being built in Garfield to address the healthcare "desert" in southern Bergen County.

We are dedicating significant resources to BVMI@UnityHealth to bring free, high-quality healthcare to working, uninsured adults in Garfield and surrounding Bergen County towns in early 2025. Patients will have access to the same excellent primary care and wellness support programs offered in Hackensack, plus a new vision care program.

In preparation for the Garfield opening, we are investing in medical equipment, hiring staff, and recruiting more clinical and general volunteers. At the same time, we are working diligently to expand services to hundreds of new patients with complex medical needs.

Through our network of healthcare and community partners, we aim to double the size of our patient population to meet the increasing need. We cannot accomplish any of this without our generous supporters, who ensure that BVMI has the necessary resources to improve the health and lives of thousands of residents in need.


