On May 19, we held our longawaited ribbon cutting for BVMI@ Unity Health in Garfield, celebrating a unique collaboration called Unity Health Partnership between BVMI, Community Food Bank of NJ, CBH Care, and Greater Bergen Community Action.

BVMI@Unity Health will provide the same healthcare services and case management support as in Hackensack with the addition of eye care services—and help cut our lengthy wait list for expert primary care, diabetes prevention, care and management, mental health services, women's health services, and chronic disease management.

Thanks to our generous supporters, more people will feel better, see

better, and have a pathway to a healthier future for themselves (and their families who rely on them) without worrying about how they will pay for it. In Garfield alone, 14.8% of residents live in poverty and 18.6% are working but uninsured—more than double the numbers for the rest of Bergen County.

The Garfield clinic will be open two days per week (Wednesday and Thursday) to start, and our staff will begin seeing patients there in early July. Those seeking an appointment for our free healthcare services can contact BVMI's Eligibility Office at (201) 342-2478 to begin the screening process.

The services provided by BVMI are very much needed in Garfield and southwest Bergen County. I am honored to be part of bringing this resource to the hardworking people of this community.
